There isn't a whole lot to say about this European style Lager from the Esk Brewery in Launceston, Tasmania. From what I gather it is made with Pilsner malts, but to me it tatstes a lot like most other "premium" styles of beer. It has a malt sweetness that is difficult to explain. There is little to no hop character, but is very clean and refreshing when it is extremely cold. The head is surprisingly big on this beer and laces all the way down the glass.
