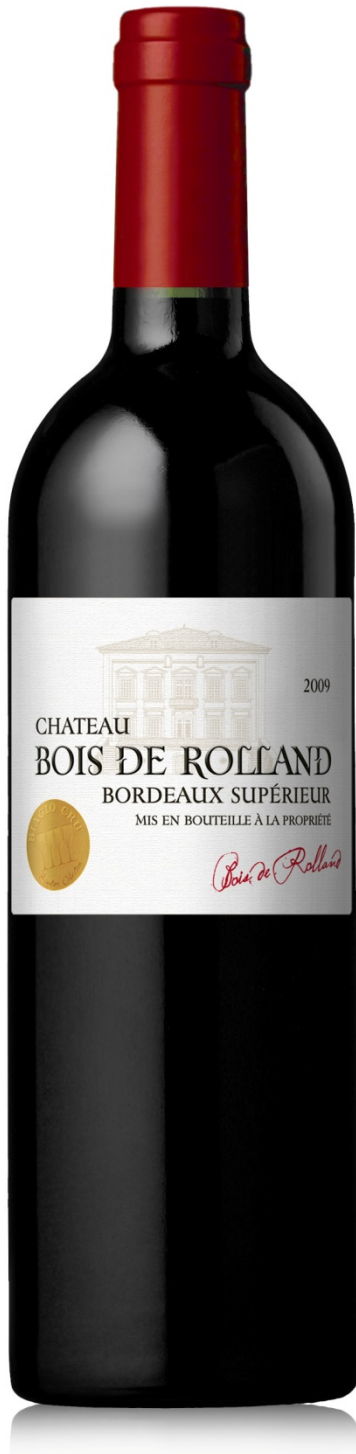


# CHATEAU BOIS DE ROLLAND

## *BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR*



### VINTAGE

The 2009 weather conditions have been particularly favorable for the vine's growth cycle and the grapes' ripening process. The 2009 vintage in Bordeaux is considered one of the best vintages of the last decades-

### RAW MATERIAL

- 70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc
- Vineyards more than 40 years old – Bordeaux Supérieur
- The grapes come from various hectares of hillside vineyard consisting of a chalky clay soil base, which contributes to give aromatic and high complexity and character.

### WINEMAKING

- This wine is made in stainless steel tanks.
- Fermentation is done under strict temperature control, with a gradual thermal increase in temperature not surpassing 30° C, permitting a high controlled extraction of the grapes' best characteristics, total maceration time around 25 days.
- 4 months rest in oak barrels.
- 8 months rest in stainless steel tanks to blend the aromas before bottling.

### TASTING NOTES

- Dark cherry-red color. Intense and very well-balanced- Elegant and attractive notes of ripe red and black berries, with hints of Spice, toasty-
