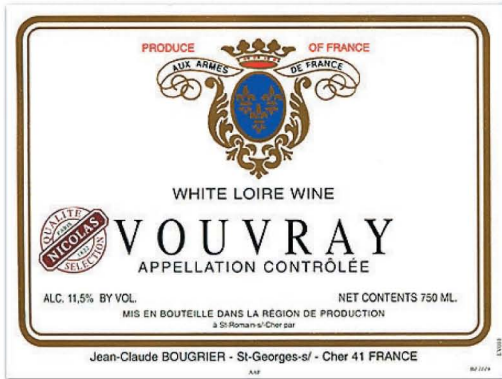
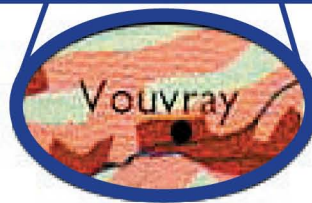


Vouvray Bougrier
