

2009 Firesteed Oregon Pinot Gris

In 2009, an average fruit-set and warm summer set the stage for an exceptional vintage. Ripening simultaneously this year, vineyards in both the Willamette Valley and warmer Rogue Valley of Southern Oregon began harvesting on September 25th with a few cooler sites lingering until October 16th.

By blending several vineyard sources and regions and avoiding heavy-handed winemaking techniques we hope to achieve a balanced wine focused on the abundant varietal fruit character of this classic grape.

The Firesteed 2009 Pinot Gris offers tropical aromas of kiwi and mango followed by flavors of perfectly-ripe summer melon and citrus. With each return to the glass, the flavors expand on the palate with increasing complexity and texture.
