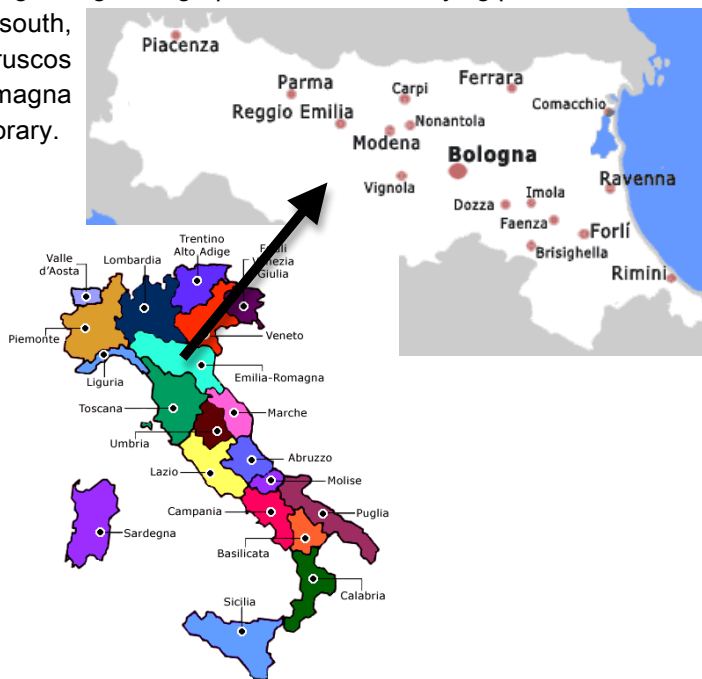


## about emilia-romagna

Melandri is located in the north-central region of Italy called Emilia-Romagna, about two hours south of Milan. The Emilia-Romagna region - commonly referred to as the "Bread Basket of Italy"- produces such popular delicacies as Parmigiano Reggiano cheese, Prosciutto di Parma ham and Balsamic Vinegar. The very lay of the land in Emilia-Romagna makes it perfect for growing wine grapes. From the low-lying plains that flank the River Po to the hills and Apennines further south, with the Malvasia of Piacenza's hills and the great Lambruscos of Reggio Emilia and Modena, the soil of Emilia Romagna yields wines that are lively, fresh and thoroughly contemporary.

There are five Lambrusco DOC regions: Lambrusco Grasparossa di Castevetro, Lambrusco di Sorbara, Lambrusco Salamino di Santa Croce, Lambrusco Reggiano, and Lambrusco Mantovano.



## Melandri Lambrusco Emilia IGT - Emilia-Romagna, Italy

### lambrusco cooler

#### Ingredients

1 bottle Melandri Lambrusco  
1 bottle lemon Italian soda, chilled  
8 ounces cherries, pitted and quartered  
8 ounces strawberries, hulled and sliced.

#### Directions

Put 1 cup of lemon soda in a large pitcher with cherries and strawberries and crush the fruit using a wooden spoon to release the juices. Chill at least 4 hours or overnight. To serve, stir in Lambrusco and remaining soda and pour over ice.
