



DOURO

Oldest demarcated wine region in the world. Definite sense of terrior from steep, slate based slopes.

Very structured and firm. This red has dense tannins overlaying the black currant fruit. Its dry solid texture dominates yielding an impressive wine that has fine juicy fruit now and will age well over many years.



ALENTEJO

Spanning a third of Portugal, this region benefits from warmth, bright sunlight and a patchwork of soil that helps create big, bold wines.

Very intense aromas, dominated by blackberry, nuts, and aromatic plants. Callabriga Alentejo Red is full-bodied and has lively, firm tannins and a robust finish.

Aged for 1 year in 225-liter oak barrels and 6 months in bottle.
