
Acanteo Grillo SICILY

Grillo, also known as Riddu and Rossese bianco, is a white Italian wine grape variety which withstands high temperatures and is widely used in Sicilian wine-making and, in particular, for Marsala. Intriguing and intense floral aromas, with notes of citrus, peach, almonds and sweet grass.



Acanteo Syrah SICILY

Syrah is a noble Mediterranean grape which gives of its best in bright dry places like our Sicily. This interpretation of Syrah is produced in a modern style, Powerful, impenetrable, dark fruit and spicy.





Nero d'Avola ("Black of Avola") is the most important red wine grape in Sicily" and is one of Italy's most important indigenous varieties. It is named after Avola in the far south of Sicily and its wines are compared to New World Shirazes, with sweet tannins and plum or peppery flavors.
